**REGULATIONS OF THE COMPETITION
"ARCTIC YAKUTIA AND THE RUSSIAN FAR EAST
AS THE PARTNER REGIONS OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA"**

1. General Provisions

1.1 M.K. Ammosov North-Eastern Federal University (NEFU) and the Department of Russian of the Hankuk University of Foreign Studies conducts the competition “Arctic Yakutia and Russian Far East as Partner Regions of South Korea” among students, citizens of the Republic of Korea (hereinafter - the Competition).

1.2. This Regulation establishes requirements for the competition participants (hereinafter referred to as participants) and works, the procedure for submitting works for the competition, the timing of the competition, and regulates the rights and obligations of the organizers and participants.

1.3. The organizer of the competition is the M.K. Ammosov North-Eastern Federal University (hereinafter - NEFU) and the Department of Russian of the Hankuk University of Foreign Studies.

1.4. The competition is supported by:

- Directorate of the Forum "Dialogue: Russia - Republic of Korea";
- Fund of the target capital of NEFU (Endowment Fund).

2. The competition goals and objectives

2.1. The goal of the competition is to identify and develop talented youth of the Republic of Korea, showing interest in Russia and Russian Far East, deepening interstate cooperation in this area by actively involving students in joint educational and scientific projects.

2.2. The objectives of the competition are:

- a) formation and deepening of knowledge of Korean students about Russian Far East for the subsequent development of cooperation between the Russian Federation and the RK;
- b) development of cooperation in the field of academic mobility of students, teachers and staff, as well as in the field of science, between the universities participating in the "Dialogue: Russia the Republic of Korea" forum;
- c) creation of conditions for activating academic mobility and increasing the number of students from the Republic of Korea in Russian universities.

3. Requirements to the participants of the competition

Citizens of the Republic of Korea are allowed to participate in the competition:

3.1. Having a bachelor's degree, graduating not earlier than 2010, as well as students of the last year of study under the bachelor's program.

3.2. They speak Russian or/and English at a level not lower than B1.

3.3. Having an interest and motivation to study the regions of Russian Far East and the NorthEast of the Russian Federation and the development of international cooperation with Asian countries, including the Republic of Korea.

4. Organizing Committee

4.1. For organizing and holding the competition, the Organizing Committee of the competition is formed from the staff of the NEFU units and the Department of Russian of the Hankuk University of Foreign Studies.

4.2. The Chairman of the Competition Organizing Committee is the Head of the International Relations Office - Vice-Rector for International Cooperation of the NEFU.

4.3. The Organizing Committee of the Competition is authorized:

4.3.1. to advise the competition participants on all possible issues related to the competition;

4.3.2. to accept and register applications for participation (in electronic form);

4.3.3. to conduct competitive selection and evaluation of the received works;

4.3.5. notify the participants about the results.

5. Stages of the competition

5.1. The competition is held in distance form (a link to the electronic form) from December 10, 2019 to February 20, 2020.

The competition is held in the following stages:

a) reception of competitive works - from December 10, 2019 to February 20, 2020.

b) meeting of the Organizing Committee, consideration of the received competitive works – February 21-27, 2020;

c) announcement of the winners – March 1, 2020;

5.2. In the online application on the site of the competition the following information must be indicated: - Name and surname, date of birth, university, specialty, course, contact phone number, e-mail.

5.3. The application is considered accepted after receipt by the sender of an electronic notice to the e-mail address confirming the receipt of the competitive work.

5.4. Applications received after the specified period, as well as not containing all mandatory information, are not accepted or considered.

5.5. Based on the results of the evaluation, 3 winners of the competition are determined, who demonstrated the best results according to the criteria of the competition.

5.5.1. Three winners of the competition receive as a prize two offers (packages) for a choice:

Package 1. Semester Internship

- Coverage of travel expenses Republic of Korea-Yakutsk-Republic of Korea
- Coverage of tuition fees for one semester in NEFU in the field of their specialty or in Russian as a foreign language department.
- Covering the cost of living in a NEFU dormitory
- A one-time scholarship, including expenses for medical insurance in the amount of 20 thousand rubles, including Personal Income Tax. Net amount = 14000.

Package 2. Master's program

- Coverage of travel expenses Republic of Korea-Yakutsk-Republic of Korea
- Coverage of tuition fees in the NEFU's Master's program (from the programs offered in Appendix 1) or one-year language training (Russian language) for completion the basic educational program of the NEFU if necessary
- Covering the cost of living in a NEFU dormitory
- A one-time scholarship, including expenses for medical insurance in the amount of 50 thousand rubles, including Personal Income Tax. Net amount = 35000

5.5.2. The **Package 2** winners are also awarded with an additional bonus prize in case of a successful pass of intermediate control tests - a ticket to the NEFU's "Christmas holidays in Moscow or St. Petersburg (optional)" program (8-10 days of educational tourism as part of a group of students of NEFU, social activities, the costs of travel, accommodation, museums, excursions, etc. are covered. The dates of the trip to Moscow or St. Petersburg are in January).

5.6. Announcement of the winners of the competition is carried out with the help of an e-mail, or a phone call, posting information on the website.

6. The subject, structure and criteria of the competition

6.1. The application consists of three parts:

a) registration for the competition (participant data);

b) test of knowledge of geography, history, culture of Russian Far East, Siberia, the Northeast and the Arctic;

c) essay of at least 500 words (2 pages of A4 format) on the topic: "Arctic Yakutia and the Russian Far East as the Partner Regions of the Republic of Korea" in Russian or English;

6.2. Evaluation of competitive works is carried out according to the following criteria:

- Compliance with the essay topic of the competition;
- Possession of theoretical and factual material on the topic;
- The depth of knowledge about the region (history, culture, geography, etc.);
- Logical character of the author's text;
- General humanitarian erudition;
- Literacy.

7. Source of funding of the competition

7.1. The source of financing for the competition and prize fund is the income from the property, which is the target capital for the development of academic mobility NEFU (endowment fund).

8. Information on the conduct of the competition

8.1. This Regulation is subject to publication on the official site of the NEFU, in social networks.

8.2. Information on the competition and final results is published on the official website of the NEFU, in social networks.
